# **Drapers Field**

There are plans for the Olympic Development Agency to use the field as a car park for the duration of one year. Originally it was needed for two years, but the council negotiated the time span down to one

of the field, (for when the Olympics

are over), a consortium of organisations in the area have suggested that a residential development be built on the northern fringe of Drapers Field. However this suggestion has not been adopted by Waltham Forest Council. In fact a council officer has told Lib Dem Cllr Milton Martin that such a scheme is highly unlikely to go ahead. The officer considered it as 'unrealistic'.

During the summer of this year a full consultation will be carried out in the community to find out what local residents wish the future of Drapers Field top be.

Due to the


